

## ARTIST MENTOR APPLICATION

Mentoring youth in the arts at New Urban Arts is a volunteer position. Each volunteer contributes at least 4 hours a week between October and May and also participates in a professional development program of monthly meetings, a two-day orientation in September, and a full day retreat in February. Artist mentors receive a small honorarium in appreciation for their contribution. Artist Mentors must be available in the afternoons, preferably 3-5pm, at least two days per week.

### EXPECTATIONS: MENTOR ORIENTATION: Sat. 9/29- Sun. 9/30

GUIDE a group of high school students in the arts, twice a week for two hours each session from October-May.

PARTICIPATE in a yearlong professional development program.

DOCUMENT student work, with an emphasis on process and voice, for gallery viewing.

COMMIT to mentoring and learning in a diverse educational environment.

INTRODUCE a variety of new media/techniques/resources

COLLABORATE with artist mentors, students, staff, and community.

EXHIBIT your own artwork in our gallery in November.

Under the direction of the Director of Programs, each Artist Mentor will:

### **ENGAGE AND GUIDE** a group of 5-10 high school students at a time:

- Introduce new media and techniques.
- Encourage students to incorporate various media within their artwork.
- Document student work and progress.
- Prepare artwork for public exhibitions.
- Design and implement long-term projects.
- Communicate with your mentees regularly.
- Demonstrate effective use of studio environment, including respect and responsibility for studio space and materials.
- Introduce students to new media, artists, galleries, libraries, museums, books.

### **BUILD RELATIONSHIPS** with young people through creative practice and community building:

- Respond to the diversity of backgrounds and experiences of students.
- Model creative process and building community within your mentoring group.
- Use an inquiry, asset-based, and supportive approach to meeting students' needs that promotes self-esteem and positive self concept for youth.

### **CREATE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT** for students to develop their creative practice:

- Create a learning environment clear of bias and judgment.
- Promote an atmosphere of collaboration and high expectations for each student.
- Support students to grow and learn.

#### **PARTICIPATE** in a year-long professional development program:

- Attenda two-day mentor orientation in the fall.
- Participate in monthly mentor trainings and meetings.
- Attend a mid-year retreat in February.
- Reflect upon your own artistic and educational practices through group and individual activities.

#### **CONTRIBUTE** to New Urban Arts community:

- Attend organizational events, including exhibitions, performances, workshops, and fundraisers.
- Exhibit you own artwork in our gallery in November.
