Working with artist mentors Aneudy Alba and Marguerite Keyes, create new work around this summer's theme: *Faking It*.

Spend the summer exploring ideas of belief and doubt, forgery and fabrication, authenticity and authorship, lies and deception. Create counterfeit artifacts and attempts at trompe-l'œil. Make reproductions, replicas, parodies, and mischief. Study the art of illusion and the art of the hoax. Youth receive a \$400 stipend for participation.

Through creative writing and conversation, investigate gender, relationships, identity, and stereotypes. Working with artist mentors Sydney Peak and Jorge Vargas, explore inequities around language, privilege, and power.

Students who identify as female attend Monday, Wednesday, and Friday. Students who identify as male attend Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Youth receive a \$400 stipend for participation.

The specific program schedules are mandatory for paid summer apprenticeships in the arts at New Urban Arts.
